Hope for the Hurting

Life is painful various challenges, difficulties, bumps and bruises that can leave us lost and drowning in their wake. But Jesus said, *“In this world you will have tribulations . . .”* In this Bible study, Dr. Tony Evans offers spiritual principles for facing such pain and hurt with a biblical perspective. Love and happiness are on the other side if we learn how to walk through the hurt with both peace and joy. **6 Week Course**

Share Jesus without Fear

This study presents a simple and relational approach to sharing the gospel and helps equip the believer to present it with a level of comfort and confidence. It gives you scriptures to use to answer objections and teaches believers how to navigate a witnessing conversation in everyday situations. **5 Week Course**

Abide In Christ

This **6-session** study of Jesus' parable of the vine in John 15 helps believers experience a relationship with Christ that results in victorious Christian living, meaning relationships with others, and fruitful service. It focuses on the importance of relying on your connection to Jesus Christ for power, strength, and endurance in your Christian walk.

The Call

This **6-session** study answers the question **"Who am I as a disciple of Christ?"** It begins by exploring the question **"Who is Jesus?"** Then it takes group members through the priorities of a disciple, the cost of a disciple, and the fruit of a disciple. True discipleship will cost, but the sacrifice will yield eternal rewards.

God's Faithfulness in Samson's Life

This **4 week study** is a verse by verse examination of Judges 13-16 that walks you through God's faithfulness in the life Samson who had struggles while in possession of God's anointing.

The Way

This **5-session** study acquaints believers with the way Jesus calls, teaches, equips, and sends His followers focusing on the journey of Jesus' with the original 12 disciples. It pinpoints the methods Jesus used to pour and invest into the disciples He would eventually send out into the world to make disciples of others.
