- **MONDAYS:**

- **Fellowship with Believers (Women)**

- *Fellowship with Believers helps believers understand the nature of the church as a whole and how it functions as the body of Christ. This study teaches how to develop healthy relationships, spend time with other believers, help one another grow strong in the Lord, and serve together to accomplish His kingdom purposes. **6 Week Course***

- **The Disciples Mission (Co-Ed)**

- *This six-week study helps Christians understand how to be on mission with God and to help others develop growing relationships with Christ. Topics include righting wrong relationships, witnessing through relationships, nurturing new Christians, maturing as a disciple, making disciples, and developing co-laborers with a kingdom perspective. **6 Week Course***

- **TUESDAYS:**

- **The Truth (Co-Ed)**

- *This study helps disciples answer the question "What does a disciple believe?" Many people will claim Christianity, but do they really know what they believe? Do they know the doctrines of the faith? The Truth challenges students to take a deeper dive into six core doctrines: God as triune creator, the reality of sin, the Person and work of Christ, the kingdom of God, and the church. **6 Week Course***

- **It's Not Too Late (Co-Ed)**

- *If you've ever wondered, "Is it too late for God to do something with me?" This study is for you. God frequently uses broken people to accomplish His purposes on earth. A broken person who has learned dependence on God is a force to be reckoned with. This six-session study looks at three men and three women of the Bible who were used mightily by God despite their previous mistakes. You too can learn to focus on the potential of your future, not the missteps of your past. **6 Week Course***

- **THURSDAYS:**

- **Jonah (Co-Ed)**

- *This study is a chapter/verse examination of the book of Jonah working through the dynamic between man's disobedience and God's deliverance. God being merciful, can provide opportunity and second chances for people, who in our estimation, don't deserve it, but we forget we are recipients of His mercy as well. **5 Week Course***

- **The Disciples Personality (Co-Ed)**

- *In this six-week study disciples will learn how to share their personal testimonies. Topics include: doing God's will, renewing the mind, mastering the emotions, presenting the body, and being filled with the spirit. **6 Week Course***

- **SATURDAYS:**

- **Life Lessons from Women (Women)**

- *This study examines the lives of women in the Bible and challenges women today to apply what they learn. This Bible study is helpful to new believers who are beginning to study God's Word, as well as mature Christians who desire a deeper understanding of Scripture. Focus on women in various ages and stages of life and dive into the culture, families, and testimonies of these women. **6 Week Course***

Brief History of Kettering Baptist Church

Kettering Baptist Church was founded as a Southern Baptist Church mission on October 17, 1969 under the sponsorship of Kent Baptist Church of Landover, Maryland and others. It was the first church founded in the evolving Kettering community. The first services were held at Kettering Elementary School and in 1972 the mission began building an edifice at its current site, which was dedicated in April 28, 1974. It became incorporated as Kettering Baptist Church on April 4, 1973. In 1993, the church expanded its dwelling to include the erection of a 5,408 square foot educational building. Several interim pastors served the church beginning with Pastor Roger Berhauser (1969), Pastor Charles Stover (1970-71), Pastor Larry Kalb (1974-77), and Pastor Harry Hoback (1978-87). The fulltime pastors were: Pastor Billy Comfort (1971-74) and Pastor David Keyser (1987-1998). Our current and longest serving fulltime pastor is Pastor Bucas Sterling III (2000 until present); he is also our first African American pastor. Under Pastor Sterling's leadership the membership of the church has experienced tremendous expansion since 2000, growing from less than 100 members to well over 1000 members and an unknown number of radio audience who tune in regularly locally on FM radio and nationally on XM Sirius radio. Church expansion to the Legacy Center on 27 acres of land, located on Crain Highway in Upper Marlboro, Maryland, was completed in December 2016. Since the Pandemic, our reach has expanded tremendously to a virtual audience via: Livestream, available on our website, Facebook, and YouTube. As a result, our viewing audience as well as members are not only local, but exist nationally and internationally. We have intentionally provided hybrid opportunities for Sunday Morning Services, Sunday School, DTM Classes and Evening Bible Studies to meet the needs of those attending in person and those participating virtually. God has found favor with Kettering Baptist Church and He continues to open opportunities for the expansion of its service.
