DTM Fall Semester 2025 Session B Class Descriptions

Suffering's Consolation

The study is an examination of 1 Peter. The Apostle Peter was a man of faith with and an eyewitness to the life of Christ. He challenges us to look beyond our current circumstances to a future inheritance. In the midst of suffering and persecution, Peter helps readers discover what it means to experience the Living Hope they have in Christ. **This is a 5-week course.**

The Life

This book study answers the question "What does a disciple do in relationship with God?" In this class of developing disciples, each group member discusses and practices the following disciplines: reading and studying scripture, prayer, community, being filled with the Spirit, serving, and evangelism. This is a 6-week course.

The Call

The Call Bible Study Book is an intentional 6-session disciple-making study that answers the question "Who am I as a disciple of Christ?" It begins by exploring the questions "Who is Jesus and what did He do?" Then it takes group members through the priorities of a disciple, the cost of a disciple, and the fruit of a disciple. This is a 6-week course.

Spiritual Gifts

This Bible study examines spiritual gifts biblically, helping participants see what the gifts are (and are not). Each session answers a specific common question about spiritual gifts, including how to discover and use the gifts God has given you. In this course you can expect to Develop a biblical understanding of spiritual gifts, identify your gifts and see how spiritual gifts are used in community. This study also includes a Spiritual Gifts Evaluation to help you to discover what Spiritual Gift you may have. This is a 6-week course. (Women Only and Virtual Only)

The Way

This is a study that acquaints disciples with the way Jesus calls, teaches, equips, and sends His followers. Focusing on the journey of Jesus' original disciples, **The Way** helps new and growing disciples walk through the Gospels, following Jesus and His methods. **This is a 5-week course.**

Fatherhood is more than just protecting and providing for your kids. Being a dad is one of the most important and influential roles a man could ever play in his life. This final volume of 33 The Series will help you begin to think strategically about being a dad. A Man and His Fatherhood provides insights and biblical truth that can carry you through the confusion and dark moments of fatherhood and also energize you for its high points and powerful moments. This is a 6-week course

Naomi

Naomi's story, found in the book of Ruth, is a story of lost identity. She lost her husband and her sons, which in her culture left her completely without a home or a means to support herself. She reacted by letting her circumstances define her. But even in her angry, fearful, rather dramatic season of feeling like the victim, God kept showing His faithfulness. You'll learn that when we go through trauma, loss, and hardship, it's normal to feel like giving up. Yet God remains close. He is not done. He can and will redeem even in our darkest circumstances. **This is a 4-week course. Women Only and Virtual Only.**
