Class Descriptions

The Disciples Victory

This class is designed to help you achieve victory in spiritual warfare. In this study you will focus on outer victory as you learn how to advance against the enemy in spiritual warfare. You will learn the defensive weapons of the Spiritual Armor, which protect you, and the offensive weapons, which lead you to advance against the world, the flesh, and the devil. **This is a 6-week course.**

John's Gospel Pt. 1

This study walks us through the first 12 chapters of the Gospel of John. John's theme concerning Jesus Christ is that He is God in the flesh. Jesus was more than just a man, a teacher, or prophet. He is The Word Who became flesh and dwelt among us. This study will examine Jesus life in light of His divinity. The miracles, teachings, and personal encounters point to Jesus, as God, dwelling among men. **This is a 6-Week course.**

The Awe of God

Do you long for an intimate relationship with God but He seems elusive? Perhaps it's because something essential is missing in your life—*the fear of the Lord*. Fearing God is very different than being afraid of God. It's the key to everything. If you want to build a faith that stands strong through troubled times, fearing God should be an essential characteristic of your relationship with Him. Embracing a Holy Fear yields rewards like holiness, wisdom, legacy, confidence, happiness, and peace of mind. **This is a 6-Week course.**

When God Doesn't Fix It

Can blessings arise from broken dreams? Can good fortune and peace come out of misfortune? God doesn't promise to save us from all hardship. No matter how hard we pray, sometimes our circumstances don't change. Tackling common myths about God and difficult experiences, the study examines what happens when life doesn't turn out the way we expect---and offers assurance that although our situation may never get better, we can grow and not get bitter but better because of it. **This is a 5-week course.**

Men's 33 Part 6: A Man and His Fatherhood

Fatherhood is more than just protecting and providing for your kids. Being a dad is one of the most important and influential roles a man could ever play in his life. This final volume of **33 *The Series*** will help you begin to think strategically about being a dad. *A Man and His Fatherhood* provides insights and biblical truth that can carry you through the confusion and dark moments of fatherhood and also energize you for its high points and powerful moments. **This is a 6-week course**

Hagar

Hagar's story is found in Genesis 16. She was betrayed, abandoned, and scorned. Her response? She did what some people would do when deeply hurt by someone they trust--she ran away. She got defensive. She retreated to a place where she felt safe. She felt justified in her anger and hurt. But deep in her core was a woman who longed to be seen and hoped for redemption. Follow Hagar as she learns from hurt and heartache that what is unresolved is not unseen by God. The lack of finality in Hagar's story teaches us to trust God with the ending—believing that he sees us and knows. **This is a 4-week course.**
