Respectable Sins Pt. 1

We can become so focused on the obvious sins in society that we overlook the “smaller” sins in our own lives. This study looks at “acceptable” sins we often tolerate in ourselves, such as jealousy, anger, judgmentalism, selfishness, pride, and ingratitude. It will point us to the hope of the gospel, God’s mercy, and His grace to help us overcome our “respectable sins.” **This is a 5-week course.**

Forgiving What You Can’t Forget

When you have been deeply hurt, forgiveness can feel unrealistic. Yet forgiveness is a central part of the Christian faith, and God calls us to forgive. Still, many of us have questions: How does forgiveness work? Why is it so important? When should I forgive? How can I find healing? Are there exceptions? This study explores these questions from a biblical perspective, helping you move toward the grace of forgiveness and freedom from the pain of past wounds. **This is a 6-week course.**

A Kings Heart for a King Part 2

King David was known as a man after God’s own heart, a distinction not given to any other king in Scripture. While other kings were described as good or evil, David was uniquely recognized in this way. Why was David given this title, and why were other kings not described the same way? This study will examine the lives of four kings of Israel, exploring their mindsets, behaviors, and actions. This course is the conclusion of a two-part study. **This is a 4-week course.**

Hagar

Hagar’s story in Genesis 16 powerfully speaks to anyone who has experienced betrayal, abandonment, or rejection. Deeply wounded by someone she trusted, Hagar ran away while still longing for redemption. This study invites you to discover how God sees, affirms, and cares for those who feel overlooked. What remains unresolved in your life is not unseen by God. **This is a 4-week course.**

7 Laws of the Teacher Pt. 1

Whether you're a Pastor, Sunday School Teacher, School Teacher, Parent, Small Group Leader or Mentor, this study will renew your thinking about teaching and unleash your effectiveness as a communicator of biblical truth. The class will address the following topics: The Law of the Teacher, The Law of Education, The Law Activity, The Law of Communication, The Law of the Heart, The Law of Encouragement, and The Law of Readiness. **This is a 7-week course.**
